



This group oversees project monitoring, and regular reviews are conducted by the Board and CSR Committee. For CSR obligations exceeding ₹ 1 Crore, we conduct impact assessments, and the resulting reports are presented to the Board..



Focus on Aspirational Districts

The Government is committed to elevating the standard of living of its citizens and ensuring inclusive growth for all through 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas aur Sabka Vishwas'.

The Aspirational Districts Programme, led by NITI Aayog and supported by Central Ministries and State Governments, stands as India's flagship initiative. Its primary objective is to bring about rapid and impactful transformations in 112 districts that require focussed efforts for significant socio-economic progress. This encourages increased citizen participation in the economy, with districts vying to excel within the state and across the nation.

At Alkem, we wholeheartedly embrace our responsibility by allocating majority of our CSR fund to uplift two aspirational districts - Muzaffarpur, Bihar and West Sikkim, Sikkim directly contributing to their development.



Promoting not just the absence of diseases, but the highest possible level of good health and well-being is our motive at Alkem. As a part of our CSR initiatives, we constantly strive to deliver reliable medical facilities and bring health awareness in communities, while also strengthening infrastructures. As we ensure this, our motive is to bridge the gap between basic health care and the vulnerable sections of the society.

Our healthcare initiatives aim to fulfil 3 major areas

We have ensured to fulfil our cause through the below mentioned key initiatives:

Developing health centre and mobile health units

With the aim to cater to the primary health care services of the communities coming from underprivileged backgrounds in the States of Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Sikkim, Himachal Pradesh, and Gujarat, we have developed health centres and mobile health units.

Mega health and dental health check-up camps

We have supported multi-specialty health check-up camps in Bihar, in collaboration with non-Governmental organisations and Government institutions, to bring affordable healthcare accessible to people coming from economically weaker sections of society. Furthermore, we also organised dental health check-up camps in Government schools and spread awareness of oral care and hygiene.

3. Strengthening Government institutions

We believe that a good infrastructure, both of private and Government healthcare organisations, is extremely important to support the facilities available to the visiting patients. In Sikkim and Daman, the Company has supported infrastructure development at primary health centres and contributed towards enhancing the facilities. We have lent support for renovation work and have also upgraded the equipment needed for satisfactory treatment of patients.

Promoting hygiene

We are engaged in providing operational and maintenance support for toilets in public spaces.

Cancer Care Initiatives

1,00,000+

BENEFICIARIES

India's healthcare sector faces the twin challenges of accessibility and affordability. In Bihar, only 20% of the annual 1.4 Lakhs cancer cases receive treatment due to limited options and urban concentration. Alkem and Tata Memorial Centre (TMC) have partnered to provide diagnosis, screening, and treatment modalities for cancer patients, addressing the accessibility and affordability gap.



Our major cancer care initiatives include:

- Improving Cancer Care Infrastructure: Bihar, with a population of 104 Million, has only six radiotherapy centres, all in Patna, falling short of WHO/IAEA standards. To address this, we have committed ₹ 100 Crores for an Advanced Radiotherapy Block at HBCHRC in Muzaffarpur. We have also established three mini cancer units in Buxar, Jehanabad, and Bhagalpur, connected to HBCHRC via telemedicine. Plus, a dedicated canopy with seating for cancer patients is now available at Mahamana Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya Hospital in Varanasi.
- Introducing Palliative Care Units: Cancer patients face not only the challenges of the disease but also the physical, psychological, and emotional side effects of treatment. In a groundbreaking initiative, we have joined forces with TMC to develop a first-of-its-kind home-based Palliative Care Unit. This unit is designed to alleviate the suffering of cancer patients and their families, providing essential support throughout their battle with the illness.
- Driving Cancer Awareness and Early Detection: In India, 30% of the 1.5 Million cancer cases are oral cancer. To combat this, we initiated campaigns such as 'No Tobacco Zones' in public areas and conducted capacity-building sessions with grassroot health workers to raise awareness about tobacco's carcinogenic effects. On National Cancer Day, we organised workshops with medical professionals and Bihar Government dignitaries to share insights on cancer research and development.



Alkem Anaemia Mukti Abhiyaan (AAMA)

The National Family Health Survey-5, conducted by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, has revealed a worrying increase in anaemia among pregnant and non-pregnant women and children. This condition leads to fatigue, dizziness, and impaired cognition, often going unnoticed. As a pharmaceutical company, Alkem has initiated the Alkem Anaemia Mukti Abhiyaan (AAMA) programme, commencing in Gujarat, Maharashtra, West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, and Rajasthan, with the goal of transforming selected village panchayats into 'Anaemia Mukt Panchayat.'





Supporting Surgeries

To bring change in the community and spread welfare, our actions are not just limited to cancer and other ailments. Recognising that conducting surgeries like cochlear implants, spine surgeries, and cataract surgeries are often unaffordable for many, we are proud to support these life-changing procedures. By assisting with surgeries that are beyond the financial means of many individuals, we aim to improve lives and give the gift of hearing, mobility, and sight to those in need.

Cochlear implants



BENEFICIARIES

We have supported the underserved communities with cochlear implants. This implants helps the children with hearing impairment who face speech impediment issues leading to milestones. Cochlear delayed implants have been found to improve hearing by bypassing damaged portions of the ear to deliver sound signals to the auditory nerve, thereby helping the individual in overall development.



Spine surgeries

Spinal injuries and disorders can impair mobility and cause chronic pain if left untreated. Early intervention is key to preventing prolonged suffering. We have supported underprivileged communities by enabling access to affordable spine surgeries. These surgeries help patients with spinal conditions that may lead to disability if unaddressed.

Cataracts pose a threat to vision, with the potential for blindness if left unaddressed. Though common in elderly populations, cataracts can impact younger people too. Through community outreach programmes we aided underserved have with cataract areas care. spanning consultation, surgery, accommodation. spectacles. medication, transportation and follow-up.





Maternal and Child-Care Initiatives

4,000 **BENEFICIARIES** **BABY FEEDING CENTRES DEVELOPED**

Investment in maternal and infant health cultivates our collective future. One important aspect of maternal and child care is ensuring safe and comfortable public space for breastfeeding, addressing the critical need for proper nutrition and support. Alkem has came up with the idea of building baby feeding facilities at specific identified locations in Maharashtra. These centres offer suitable environment where mothers can breastfeed their babies or receive education and assistance on formula feeding. By establishing facilities at Sir JJ Hospital, Cama & Albess Hospital, and in parts of Maharashtra, we are safeguarding the health and future of both mothers and children.

India bears a significant 25% of the global Tuberculosis (TB) burden, resulting in approximately 4.5 Lakhs deaths annually. Underpriviledged communities face additional challenges in detecting and treating TB. With more than 1,700 TB cases being diagnosed and treated each year despite its small population, Sikkim, has emerged as a cause for concern within India's TB burden, necessitating a more systematic approach to actively screen for TB and address the issue comprehensively.

With the objective of eradicating Tuberculosis from targeted areas in Sikkim, we launched Project Pragati. This initiative primarily focusses on identifying and treating TB cases within the economically and socially vulnerable local communities. The overarching goal of the project is to provide comprehensive detection and treatment services, aiming to eliminate TB from Sikkim.

Support to Specially Abled Children

Quality education remains an uphill challenge for disabled students due to inaccessible facilities and untrained staff, resulting in high dropout rates. At Alkem, we believe every child, regardless of ability, can learn and grow. We break down barriers through early screening, inclusive education, and active community involvement, fostering a brighter future for these special children.

Key initiatives taken include:

- With National Association for the Blind (NAB), we have supported visually impaired children by funding NAB's braille literacy programmes. We have also provided audio books, screen readers and orientation training to visually impaired students to ensure their over-all development.
- At Bombay School for the Deaf and Mute, we have helped to upgrade their facilities and equip them with innovative tools like speech software and smart hearing aids. This empowers hearingimpaired children with the communication and academic skills needed to achieve their potential.

Provision of enabling factors for educating specially abled children





Shri Samprada Singh Scholarship Programme

The Covid-19 pandemic has hit vulnerable communities hard, leaving many lower-middle-class children orphaned and their education at risk. To address this, we have launched the Shri Samprada Singh Scholarship Programme. It funds the entire education journey, from primary school to college, for eligible children orphaned by Covid-19, removing financial barriers and securing a brighter future for these deserving students.



Establishment of Smart Classes

8,271 STUDENTS HELPED

Digital content, including videos and picture books, aid cognitive learning by enabling visualisation and improving conceptual clarity. The integration of technology in education has become vital, especially in the post-Covid-19 era of digital transformation.

As a part of school transformation projects in Jehanabad, Bihar, we are facilitating the establishment of smart classes in earmarked Government schools, supporting digital learning, and bridging the prevailing gap that exists.





Supporting Infrastructure and Developing Basic Facilities

The presence of a well-built infrastructure with sufficient space and facilities creates an inviting learning environment that motivates students and enhances their attendance and enthusiasm for learning. Near our operational sites and other designated areas, we extend our support to enhance infrastructural provisions.

During the reporting period we contributed to the following:

- Facilitating the construction of a Sainik school
- Operating and maintaining Anganwadi centres
- Ensuring the provision of high-quality drinking water to schools



Remedial Centres

Addressing the educational needs of underprivileged communities, we have partnered with Government educational authorities and civil society organisations to establish remedial centres in Government and Government-aided schools. These centres employ innovative 'play and learn' techniques, led by trained teachers using diverse Teaching Learning Methods (TLMs) to drive effective academic progress for students.




Our ISSF Shooting World Champion


smile ambassadors
